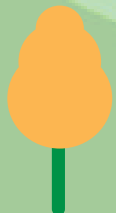

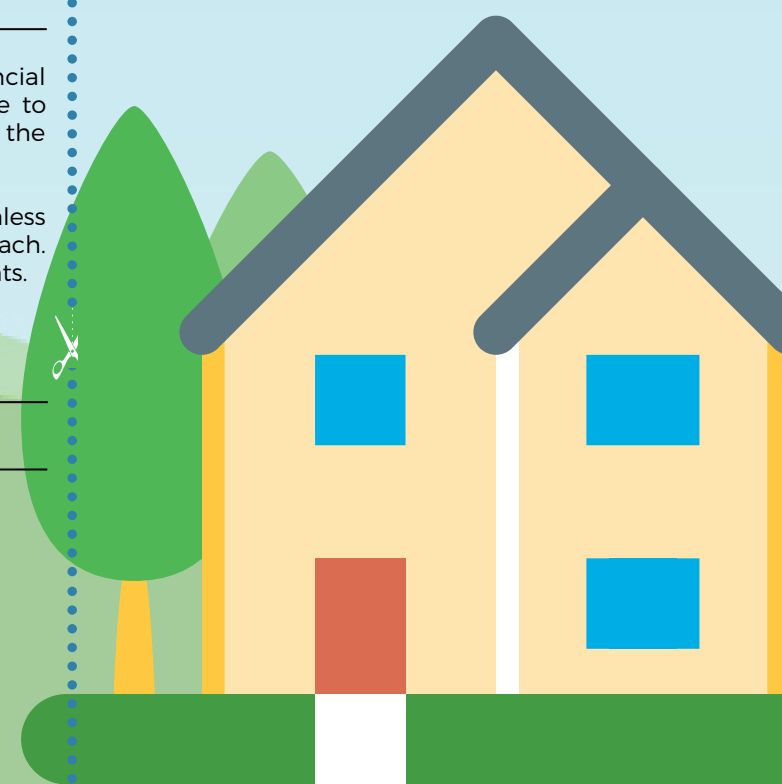

How to Pay Your Taxes

Recommended: TIPP Program

The **Tax Installment Payment Plan** allows taxpayers to have payments automatically withdrawn on the first business day of each month, or to pre-authorize a single annual payment, equal to the balance due on your property tax statement, on tax due date in September.

To apply, complete the attached application form and return it with a VOID sample cheque. To learn more, please visit steinbach.ca.



Online. When adding City of Steinbach as a payee, search "Steinbach", select the **Taxes** option. Your account number is your roll number. Enter all **13** digits of the roll number (including the preceding 451 and all zeros). Do not enter the decimal (i.e. enter 4510001234000 for roll no. 451 0001234.000).

Payments will be applied to the tax account as it is entered by the user. It is therefore **very important** to ensure the roll number(s) you have set up on your bank payment profile is the same roll number(s) that appear on your tax bill(s).

If you own more than one property, you need to make payment on each roll number separately when paying through online banking.



Mail. Along with the bottom portion of the tax bill, cheques can be made payable to City of Steinbach and mailed to 225 Reimer Avenue, Steinbach MB, R5G 2J1.



Post dated cheques. Cheques post-dated for the due date or earlier are accepted. Receipts can be re-printed upon request.



24 Hour Drop Off. Include the bottom portion of your tax bill with your payment. Drop box is located at the main entrance of City Hall facing Reimer Avenue. It is not advised to put cash in the drop box.



In Person. City Hall is located at 225 Reimer Avenue and is open Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If paying by debit, ensure you have set up the necessary limit with your bank.

Credit cards are not accepted. Receipts are not automatically mailed out. Please contact the City if you require a receipt.

Important Reminders

- **Taxes are due September 29, 2023.** Unpaid taxes are subject to a 1% penalty per month added the first business day of every month.
- **To avoid late penalty charges, consider mail delivery times and processing times for financial institutions to ensure payments are received in our office on or before the due date.**
- Tax bills cover the calendar year (January 1 - December 31, 2023).
- Failure to receive a tax notice (including new property owners) is not sufficient reason for late or non-payment; penalties will be applied.
- The 2024 Property Assessment Appeal deadline is October 10, 2023. For questions about your assessment contact the Provincial Assessment Branch at 240 - 323 Main St. Steinbach, or call 204-326-9896.

About Supplementary Taxes

- If you recently built a new home and have only received a tax bill for land, you may receive a supplementary tax bill(s). Depending on the completion date of your home and/or if the home has been assessed, you may receive a tax bill for both the previous and current year.
- **Supplementary tax bills are mailed out the first week of October and are due December 29, 2023.**

How are my Taxes Calculated?

Your property taxes are calculated using the following:

$$\text{TAXABLE ASSESSMENT} \times \frac{\text{MUNICIPAL TAX RATE}}{1000} = \text{PROPERTY TAX BILL}$$


TO DETERMINE TAXABLE ASSESSMENT, MULTIPLY YOUR 2023 ASSESSED VALUE OF HOME BY 45%

Manitoba Education Property Tax Credit Advance

2023 advances may be claimed on your personal income tax return in the spring of 2024.
