

# CITY OF STEINBACH

## By-Law 1679

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of Steinbach  
to provide for handi-cap parking.

WHEREAS Section 283 of *The Municipal Act* reads as follows:

“(1) An urban municipality with at least 1,000 residents, must, ... by by-law, make it an offence for a person to stop, stand or park a motor vehicle in a designated parking space, or in a manner that makes a designated parking space inaccessible, unless a permit is displayed in the vehicle and is used in accordance with *The Highway Traffic Act*.”

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Steinbach in session duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions:

For the purpose of this by-law, the following definitions, as provided under Section 282 of *The Municipal Act* shall apply:

1.1) “designated parking space” means a parking space designated by signs or pavement markings as being for the sole use of motor vehicles displaying a permit and that is located

- a) on a highway or municipal road,
- b) in a public parking lot or facility, or
- c) in a private parking lot or facility to which the public has access;

1.2) “motor vehicle” means a motor vehicle as defined in *The Highway Traffic Act*;

1.3) “permit” means a physically disabled person’s parking permit issued under *The Highway Traffic Act*.

2. No person shall stop, stand or park a motor vehicle in a designated parking space, or in a manner that makes a designated parking space inaccessible, unless the vehicle displays a permit in accordance with *The Highway Traffic Act* and the regulations under that Act.

3. Every person found guilty of a breach of any provision of this by-law, shall be subject to having his/her vehicle towed away, and shall be liable to a fine of \$50.00, in addition to costs incurred.

4. That By-Law 1329 is hereby repealed.
