SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS

Your cooperation in the snow removal process is greatly appreciated...

- If a fire hydrant is located on your property, DO NOT push snow to cover it.
- Clearly mark all lawn ornaments and planters, small trees and shrubbery in order to avoid damage during snow removal.
- Windrows will be removed when sufficient snowfalls warrant.
- Please exercise caution when travelling near snow removal equipment.
- City By-Law 1856 prohibits residents from pushing snow from driveways/yards into roads, streets, lanes or ditches.
- During and after snowfalls, do not park on streets and lanes which will require snow removal. Parking on streets may resume after snow removal has been completed. Vehicles causing interference with snow removal may be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.
- Notices are posted on designated boulevards the day before snow will be removed from those boulevards. Please ensure that vehicles are removed from those streets the night before boulevard clearing takes place.

COMMUNITY COMPOST DEPOTS

The City's community compost depots will be back again this year! People will be able to drop off yard and garden waste at depots in Steinbach. The Solid Waste crew brings the material back to the Landfill for composting and the finished compost becomes available to the community the following year. SNOWMOBILES

The City of Steinbach's Snowmobile By-Law allows Steinbach residents to safely exit the city and ride on designated trails.

- Snowmobiles must be operated with care and in consideration for other persons and property.
- Snowmobiles are not permitted to trespass across private property (including the golf course) and are not permitted in city parks, cemeteries, on sidewalks or boulevards.
- Snowmobiles may be operated within the city on any street for the purpose of taking the most direct route in or out of the city to or from his/her place of residence.
- Snowmobiles must be driven as close as possible and in single line with other snowmobiles.
- Maximum speed within city limits is 20 km/hr.
- Snowmobile operators are not permitted to cross PTH 12 between Penfeld Drive and the Steinbach sign at the south end of the city or PTH 52 between Industrial Road and Hespeler Street.
- Permitted hours of operation are 7am to 11pm.
- This By-Law is enforced under the Provincial Off-Road Vehicle Act.

ATV's are not permitted within the urban area of Steinbach. Thank you for your cooperation.
