

## **National Lifeguard Award**

Mandatory Text Books and Exam are additional fees.

Pre-requisites: Bronze Cross (does not need to be current) and recognized SFA with CPR "C" (does not need to be current) by the 1st day of the course and 16 years of age by exam.

This 50 hour course (core/pool option) teaches the fundamental skills, knowledge and values of safety supervision and rescues in a pool environment. Candidates are evaluated throughout the course and with a final practical exam. Successful completion of course and exam will certify candidates to Lifeguard in Manitoba. Please note that employment as a lifeguard also requires a current recognized SFA with CPR "C" certification.
