6. Council meeting recessed and Public Hearing was called to order at 7:37 p.m., by Mayor Earl Funk. Public Hearing was to consider rezoning By-law 2253.

By-Law 2253 - Rezoning
Owner: 5563985 MB Ltd. & 6135367 MB Inc.
Applicant: Kingdom Home Building Inc.
Civic Address: 40 First Street
Legal: Lot 1, Plan 5054

Purpose: To rezone the property from “RLD” Residential Low Density to “RMD” Residential Medium Density to allow for a multi-family development to be constructed.
- 6.1 Troy Warkentin, City Manager, introduced rezoning By-Law 2253, reported that notices pursuant to The Planning Act had been completed
- 6.2 Written correspondence has been received from Manitoba Municipal Relations - Community Planning Branch regarding By-Law 2243 voicing no concerns.
- 6.2 Luke Wiebe, 30017 Road 36E, of Kingdom Home Building Inc. was present at the hearing and provided the following:
 - This location is walkable to all downtown services and jobs, as well as two parks behind and across the street.
 - Access to the building will be off Giesbrecht Street, with covered parking, lobby and elevator on the main floor with residents having the luxury and privacy of entry to their units on the second and third floor.
 - They intend to build using high quality counter tops, feature walls, flooring and lighting.
 - The current home on the property is at the end of its life cycle and will be removed.
 - He has spoken with the owner of the apartment building next to the property.
- 6.3 Mr. Wiebe was prepared to answer questions of council.
- 6.4 Elaine Beckett, 22 Wyndham Estate Drive, owner of the property of 44 First Street, was present at the pubic hearing. She agreed that the plan looks much better then what is currently on the property but would like to know if what they see today on the drawing will be what is actually built. She asked when the existing house would be demolished and also requested clarification regarding green space requirements and if a variance would be required.

6.5 Administration clarified that the lot is 72 feet wide. RMD properties require a minimum of 75 feet. A minor variance would be required, which could be approved by administration.

6.6 George Wiens, 30 Giesbrecht Street was present at the hearing with concerns regarding traffic, and how it will be controlled as the street already experiences high volumes in the morning and evening. He also cited existing drainage issues and asked what would be done to manage water.

6.7. Mr. Wiebe returned to the podium and confirmed that the design presented is the building he intends to build. He confirmed that the construction design is not complete, so slight changes in dimensions, balconies etc. could change. He explained that drainage could actually improve as the property is developed and with the aid of the flat roof. He confirmed that if the rezoning is approved, he will be demolishing the house. Mr. Wiebe explained that there is green space along the west side and will be adding trees as well as saving as many trees as possible.

7. There being no further discussion, Council meeting re-opened at 8.02 p.m.

11. Troy Warkentin, City Manager presented an update to the rain event which occurred over southeastern Manitoba on September 16-17, 2024 and its impact in Steinbach:

11.1 Steinbach experienced approximately 6 inches of rainfall over two days, with more than 3 inches falling during the morning of September 17th. During and after the storm, the City's storm drainage and sanitary sewer systems were operating at full capacity.

11.2 Several dozen property owners in Steinbach contacted the City directly to report basement flooding caused by the storm.

11.3 The most intense rainfall occurred on a Tuesday morning, during regular working hours. The City's employees were generally available and were deployed as needed to assist with various storm response and mitigation efforts both during and after the event.

11.4 Since the storm, the City has been in communication with the Manitoba Emergency Measures Organization (EMO) regarding the provincial Disaster Financial Assistance program and has shared information with the public about the EMO's storm damage recovery program, which may be available to affected property owners.

11.5 Mr. Warkentin was prepared to answer questions of council.

12. Troy Warkentin, City Manager introduced Engineering Consulting Services for Lift Station 1 Upgrades & Force Main Twinning Award Recommendation and provided the following:

Summary

Purpose
To allow a daycare centre to be located on the subject property. As per Zoning By-Law 2100, a daycare centre is a conditional use in the 'C-MX' Commercial Mixed Use Zone.

Recommendation
Recommendation is to approve CU-2024-06 subject to any new evidence being presented at the public hearing.

Background

Relevant Policy

Notices pursuant to The Planning Act have been completed, and no registered objections were received as of the writing of this report. Any objections received after the writing of this report will be submitted to City Council as part of the public hearing process.

Reports

City Manager Report
The application under file CU-2024-06 seeks Council approval to permit a daycare center to be located on the subject property, which is in the C-MX - Commercial Mixed-Use Zone. Pursuant to City of Steinbach Zoning By -Law 2100, this application is subject to a conditional use approval.

The subject property is located within the Millbrook Market neighborhood - a mixed use development consisting of a mix of offices, retail, and residential. In 2020, Council approved a secondary plan for this development pursuant to By-Law 2136. This by-law supports the mixed use planning scheme for the area and provides for the development of residential and commercial uses and related services within the neighborhood.

Should Council feel that the provision of daycare services through the proposed daycare center within the development would not have a detrimental impact to the surrounding area, it may approve the application, subject to any new information that may be provided at the public hearing.

Address: 59 Market Boulevard

Current Designation and Zoning

The property is designated *Commercial* in the Steinbach Official Community Plan By-Law No. 2099

The property is zoned 'C-MX' Commercial Mixed Use in the Steinbach Zoning By-Law No. 2100.

Comments/Recommendation

The purpose for the Conditional Use application is to permit a *day care centre* within the subject property, the subject property being 59 Market Boulevard.

Under the City of Steinbach Zoning By-Law No. 2100 daycare centre is defined as “*the provision of child care services for nine or more children in a provincially-licensed facility*”. The application is to permit a daycare centre to be operated by Kinder Corner to be constructed within the Millbrook Market mixed use development. Childcare and lack of daycare spaces is an ongoing issue throughout the province, Steinbach being no exception. Any opportunity to create additional childcare spaces throughout the city should be encouraged. The city has recently seen residential development within the north west area of the city with Millbrook Market and Langill Farms. It only makes sense to create additional childcare spaces within this area of the city. Millbrook Market is being developed as a mixed use site, the addition of a daycare makes sense for this development.

It is recommended that Council approve Conditional Use CU-2024-06 subject to any new evidence being presented at the public hearing.

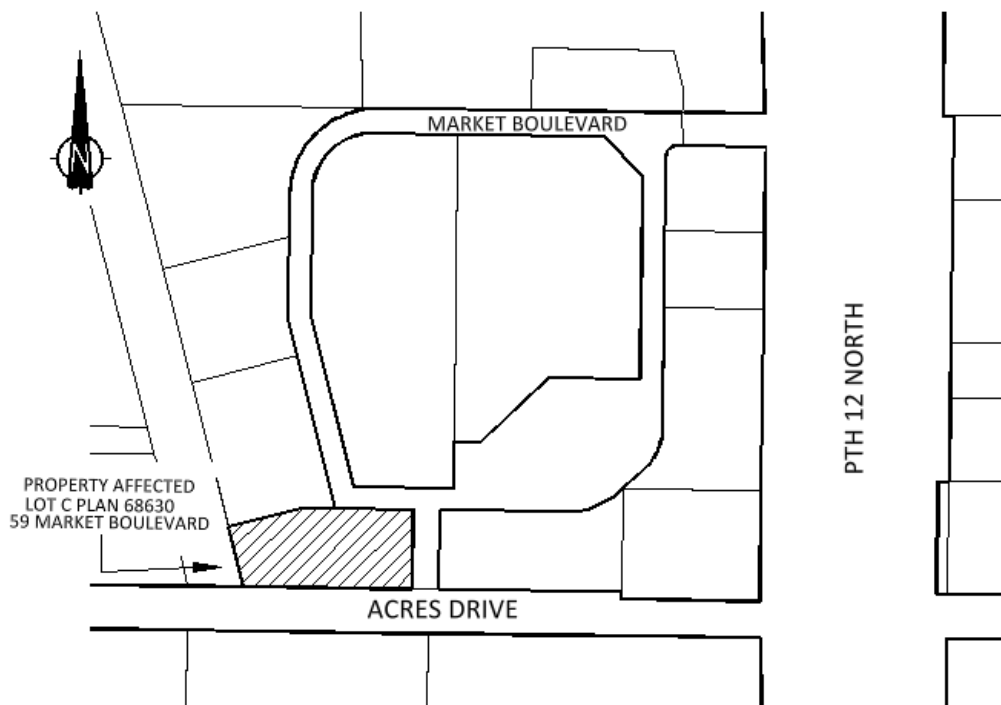

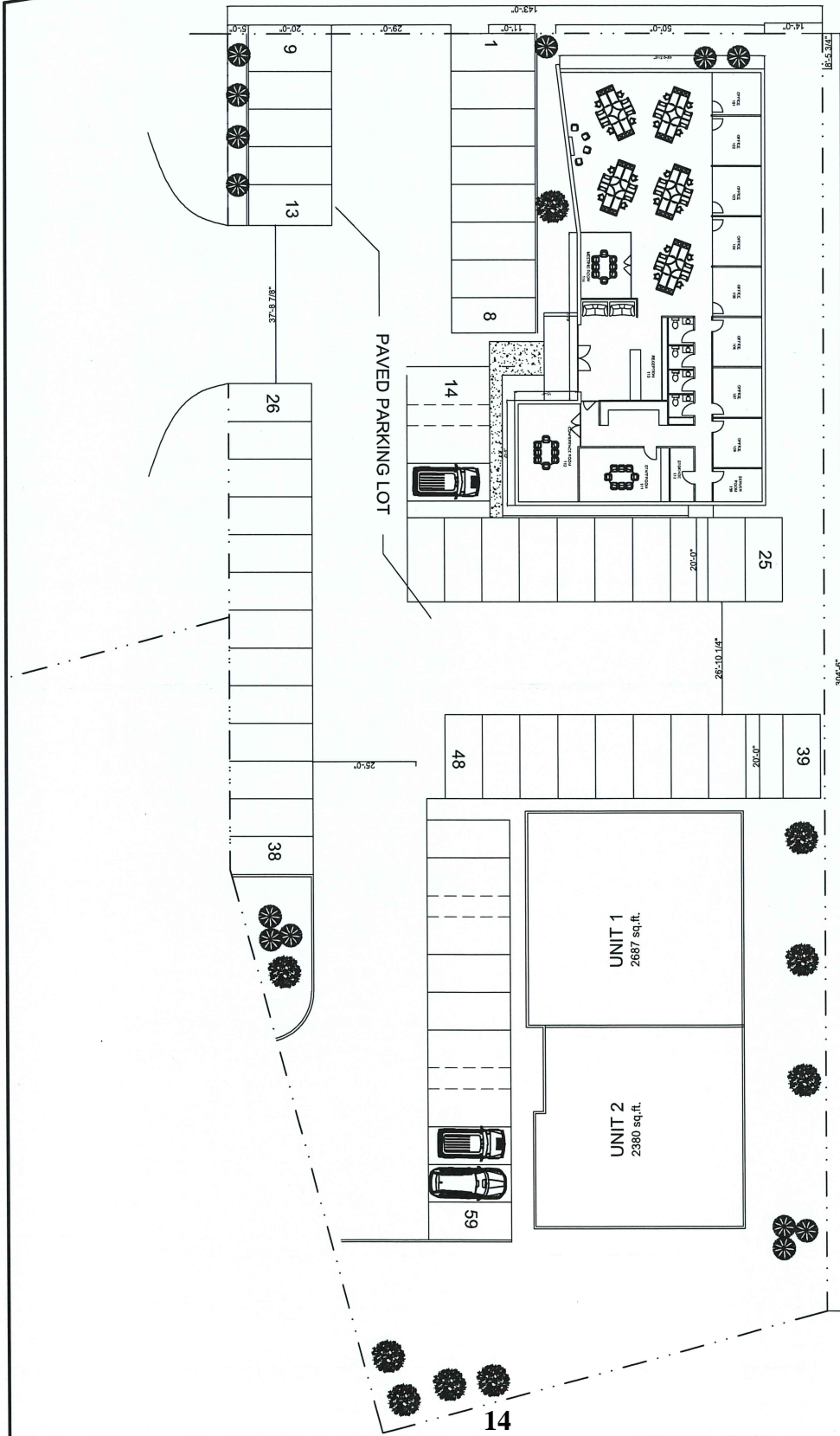

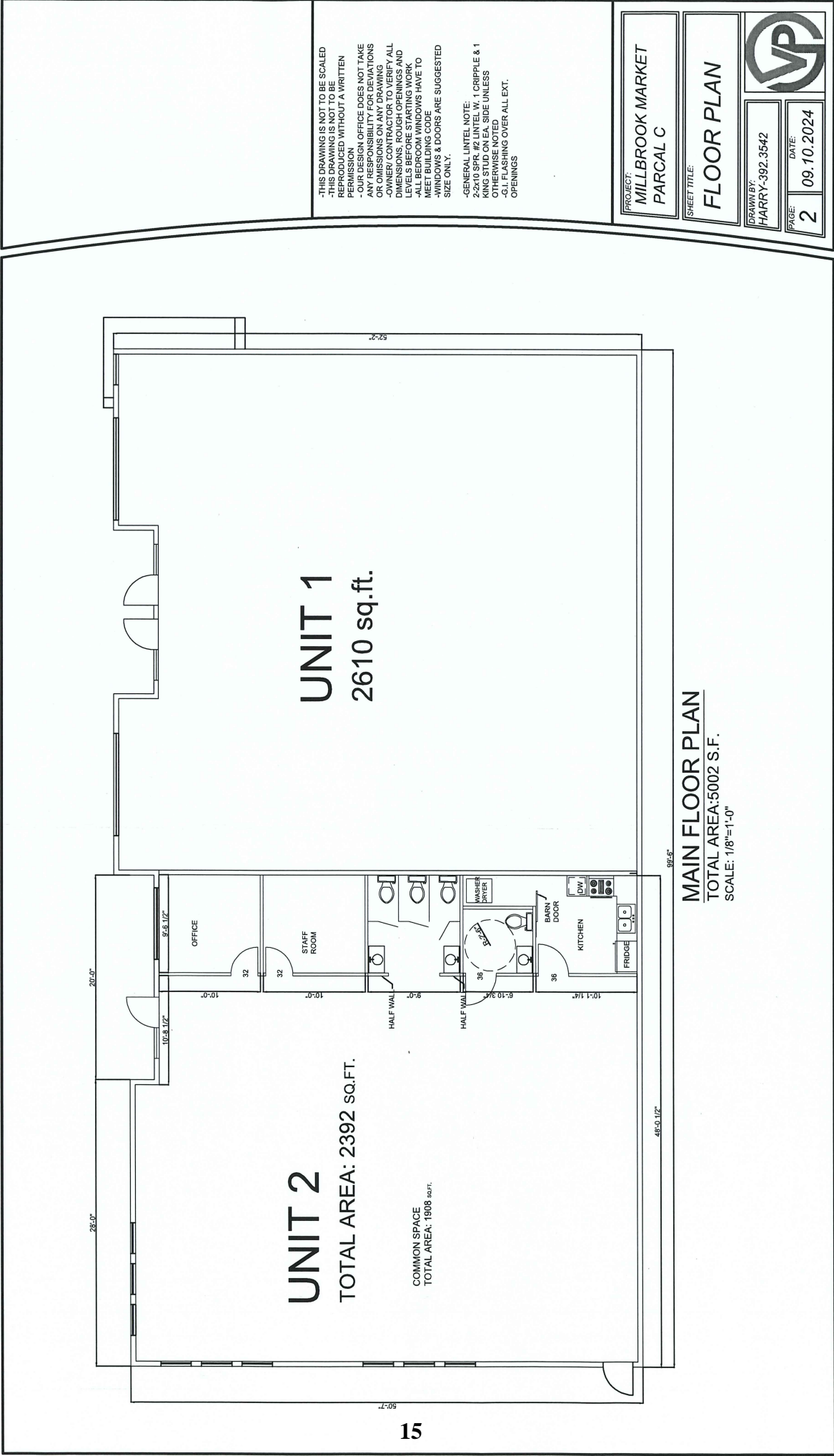

Notice re variance and conditional use applications and road openings in subdivisions

169(1) Notice of any of the following hearings must be given in accordance with this section:

- (a) a hearing on an application for a variance under section 96;
- (b) a hearing on an application to approve a conditional use under section 105.
- (c) a hearing on an application for subdivision under subsection 125(2);

Required notice

169(2) At least 14 days before the hearing, a copy of the notice of hearing must

- (a) be sent to the applicant, if there is one;
- (b) be posted in the office of the applicable planning district or municipality;
- (c) be sent to the minister, in the case of a hearing to consider a by-law to close public reserve land or the declaration of an obsolete plan; and

Notice to affected property owners

169(3) A copy of the notice of hearing

- (a) must be sent at least 14 days before the hearing to every owner of property located within 100 metres of the affected property; or
- (b) where the affected property is not remote or inaccessible, must be posted on that property in accordance with section 170.

Posting requirements

170(1) If notice of a hearing is required to be posted on an affected property under this Act, the notice must be

- (a) at least 28 x 43 centimetres in size with the words "NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING" printed in large bold letters;
- (b) posted outdoors for 14 days immediately before the date of the hearing
 - (i) in conspicuous locations on the site of the property,

 - (iii) not more than 1 metre inside the boundary lines of the property; and

Re: Notice of Bankruptcy – Shu-Pak Equipment Inc.

In 2022, the City issued a tender call for the purchase of a residential garbage truck. This truck purchase was planned to replace an existing unit in the City's fleet.

City Council approved the tender at its meeting of September 20, 2022 and awarded the purchase contract to Shu-Pak Equipment Inc. (Shu-Pak) for an amount of \$339,000.00 plus applicable taxes.

The City had successfully purchased similar equipment from Shu-Pak in 2014 and 2018.

At the time of order approval, it was acknowledged that the delivery of the unit could take up to 2 years to fulfill.

The City issued a cheque to Shu-Pak dated Sep 27, 2022 as a deposit for the approved purchase which enabled the City to qualify for a municipal customer discount.

Earlier this summer, the City received a notice of bankruptcy for Shu-Pak from the appointed receivers.

According to the notice, the total amount of debt owed by Shu-Pak exceeds the available assets of the company by a significant margin. As a result, the delivery of the previously ordered residential garbage truck will not be forthcoming. It is also unlikely that the City will be able to recover the deposit amount it provided to Shu-Pak however administration continues to work with the appointed receiver to recover the amount it is owed.

Until the matter is resolved, this amount will be reflected in the City's financial statements as an allowance for doubtful accounts.

A revised plan of equipment renewal and replacement for the solid waste department is being prepared by administration.

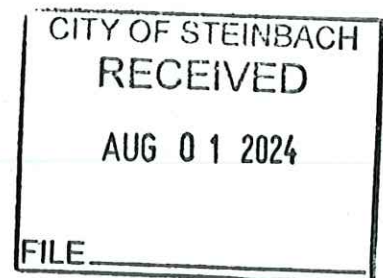

Administration's recommendation was to award the proposal and contract to Associated Engineering (Sask.) Ltd., which was the winning proposal based on the bid analysis, for the total amount of \$529,789.89 plus applicable taxes.

Subsequent to the meeting, administration discovered that it had made an error in in the recommended award amount provided to City Council.

Administration recommends that Council consider an amendment to its November 5, 2024 approving resolution to correct the public record, and approve the correct tender award amount for this work.

There is no change to the winning bid proponent – Associated Engineering (Sask.) Ltd.

A change is required to the winning bid amount, to decrease it from \$529,789.89 plus applicable taxes, as originally recommended, to \$463,201.00 plus applicable taxes, as is now verified as the corrected amount.

City Manager Report
The project proponent, Steinbach Bible College Inc., has submitted an application under By-Law 2250 requesting Council's consideration to approve a rezoning for the subject property at 333 Loewen Boulevard from C4 - Commercial Regional zone to EI - Educational and Institutional zone. The applicant intends to relocate the existing bible college from its facility at 50 PTH 12N to the subject property.

The subject property is designated Commercial Policy Area under the City's Official Community Plan. These areas are intended to provide residents with the necessary services and employment opportunities and for development that combines appropriate complementary uses within a single structure to help create a visually interesting streetscape and to encourage economic diversity.

The application notes that further development of the subject property is being planned to facilitate college operations including student housing on the site.

Recommendation from administration is that Council give By-Law 2250 third reading subject to a development agreement.

Comments

Prior to third reading of By-Law 2250 administration has made an amendment to By-Law 2250 to ensure consistency with Zoning By-Law 2100. The map within Zoning By-Law 2100 shows the subject property (333 Loewen Boulevard) as currently being zoned 'R-MX' Residential Mixed Use. In 2017 an application to re-zone the subject property from its current 'C4' Commercial Regional to 'R-MX' Residential Mixed Use was given third reading subject to a development agreement. The development agreement was never signed to enact the by-law, however the map was changed when Zoning By-Law 2100 was adopted which makes the zoning of the property 'R-MX' Residential Mixed Use. As the by-law presented to council at the previous meeting has the the present zoning as 'C4' Commercial Regional a minor amendment is required to be noted prior to third reading being given. The intent of the by-law does not change so a second public hearing is not required.

Recommendation is council give By-Law 2250 third reading as per the amendment.

Property Access

The lot has two existing undersized asphalt approaches, one from Loewen Boulevard and one from Albert Street. The approaches must be widened to a minimum width of 9.14m and constructed of concrete. The Developer will be responsible for all costs associated with installing the new 9.14m wide, 150mm reinforced or 200mm non-reinforced concrete access approach to Loewen Boulevard and to Albert Street. The Developer will also be responsible for all other costs associated with the approach reconfiguration, which includes but is not limited to construction of new curb and gutter where required, new sidewalk construction and restoration of any areas affected by construction.

Water Servicing

The existing lot is currently serviced with two 50mm water services, one from Loewen Boulevard water main and one from the Albert Street water main. The proposed development must be serviced with a minimum 50mm water service. The Developer will be responsible for all costs associated with any water service improvements, alterations or abandonments of the existing water services.

Sewer Servicing

The existing lot is currently serviced with two 150mm sewer services, one from the Loewen Boulevard wastewater sewer main and one from the Albert Street wastewater sewer main. The proposed development must be serviced with a minimum 150mm wastewater sewer service. The Developer will be responsible for all costs associated with any required sewer service improvements, as well as formally abandoning one of the existing sewer services.

Land Drainage

The Developer will be responsible to ensure that drainage, in the immediate area of this lot, functions properly. A professionally prepared "Lot Grading & Site Servicing Plan" will have to be submitted and approved by the City prior to issuance of building permits.

Garbage Pickup

This lot would receive regular commercial garbage collection.

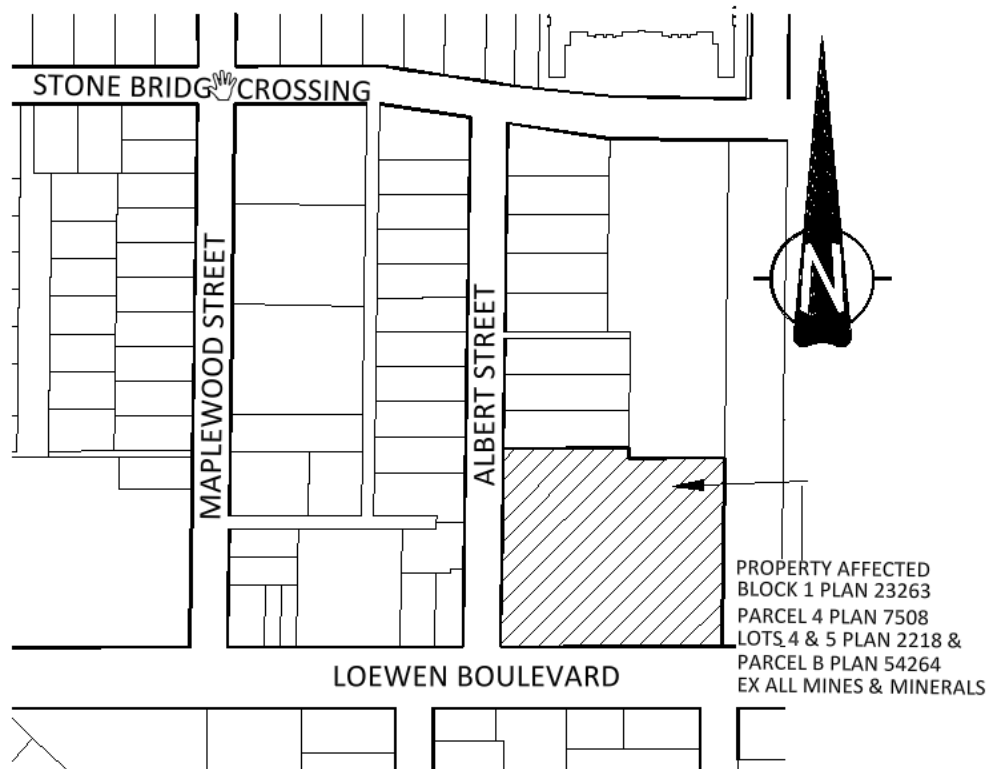

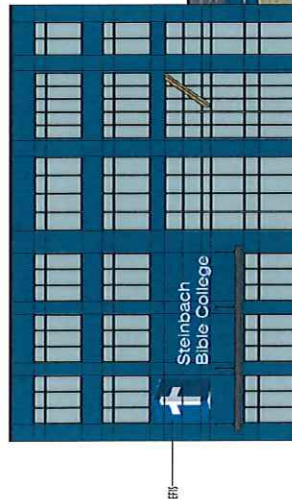
AMENDING THE STEINBACH ZONING BY-LAW 2100 MAP

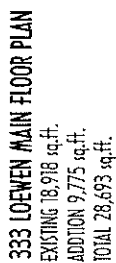

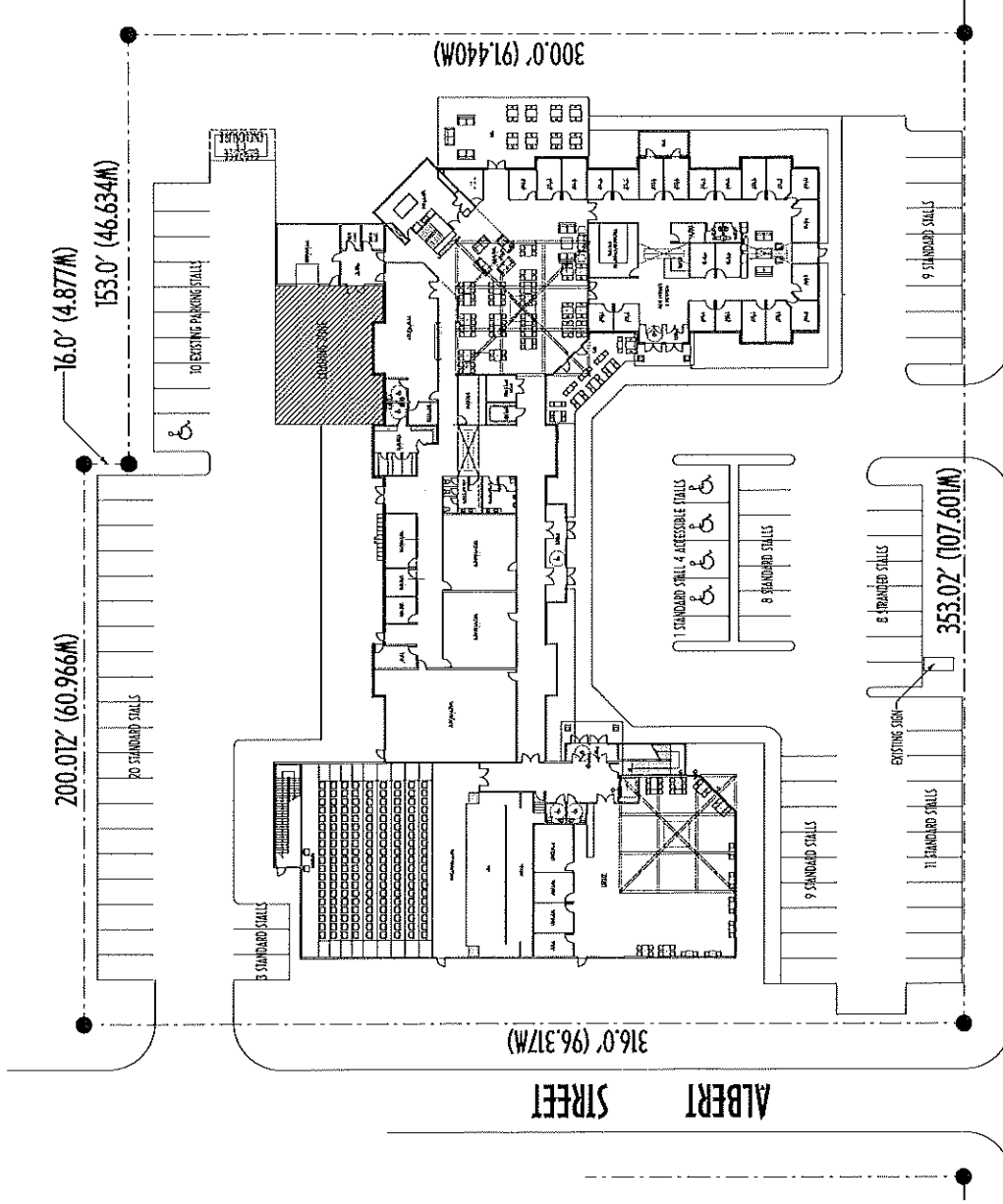

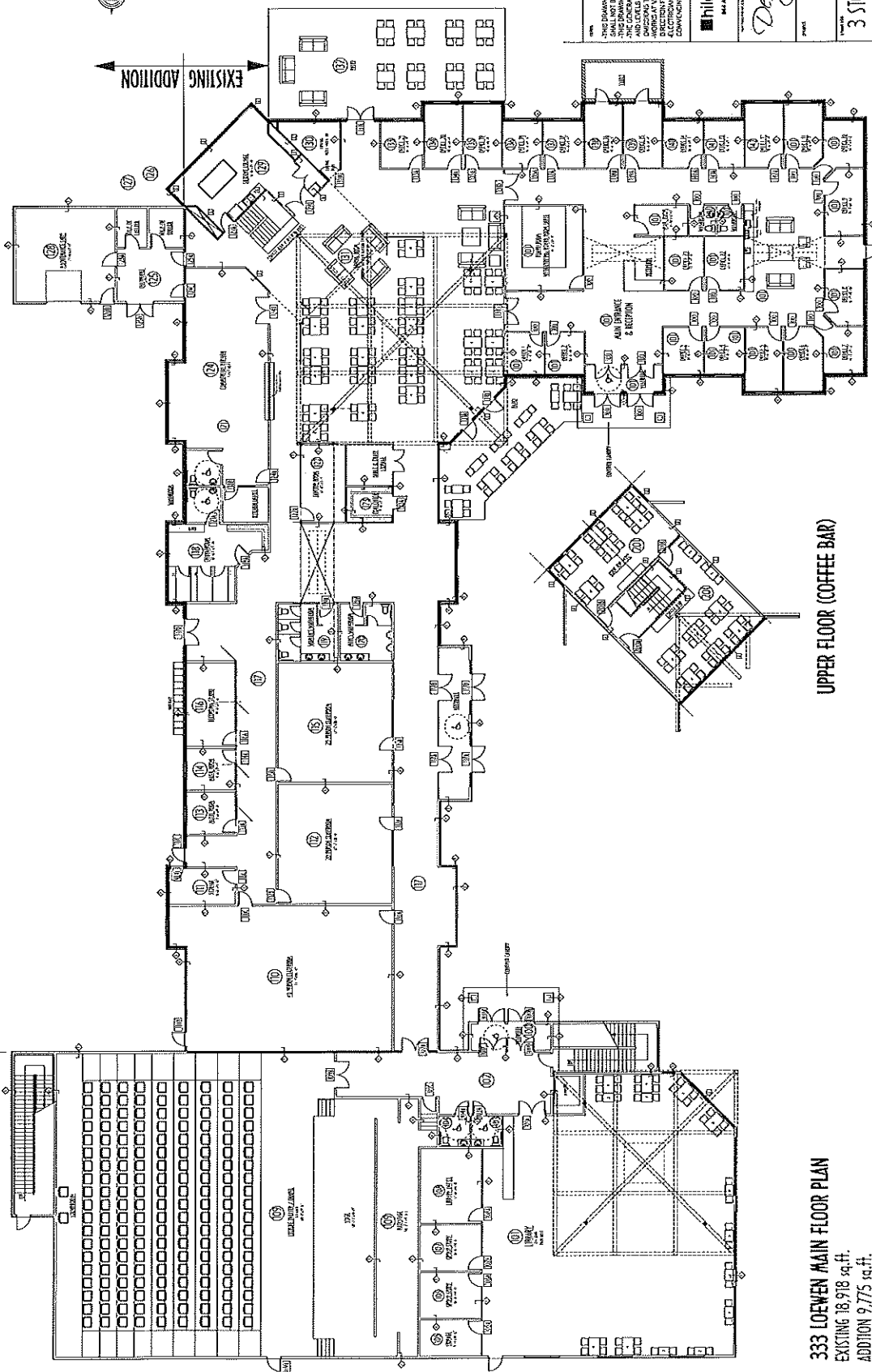

Greetings from the Leadership Council and staff at Safe Families Canada's Steinbach chapter! We are blessed to be celebrating our fourth anniversary in November 2024. In the last year, we have had the privilege of serving 14 families, including 28 children and 8 single moms, as well as welcoming our very first young adult in our Safe Families Plus program.

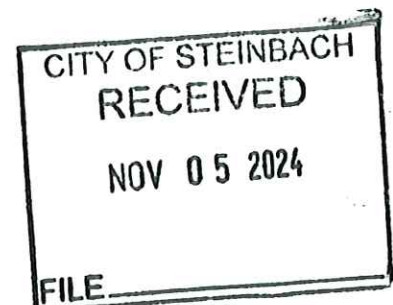
One story that had a big impact on us this year was that of a single mom of three. We had worked with her previously after she lost the love of her life to suicide and was struggling to keep herself out of addiction and be the mom her children needed her to be while grieving her loss. When she came to us again this year, she had just lost her new partner to suicide as well. She was devastated, and scared of once again losing custody of her children to CFS if she couldn't remain free of her past coping addictions. A generous Safe Families Host Family stepped up to watch her children 3 days a week over the summer to give mom a chance to grieve. We were so encouraged to see the growth and healing she had experienced since we worked with her last, as she was able to grieve without resorting to substance abuse. Her story is not finished yet, but she is making progress in providing a thriving home for her children, and we are so grateful that we were able to have a small role in her story. "Safe Families' work is amazing, I wish I would have known about it sooner." - mom

Unfortunately, we hear heartbreaking stories from families in crisis all the time. There are many families in Steinbach and the surrounding area who are facing a crisis without the support of extended family and friends, either because they are alone or their network is unhealthy; this can potentially open the door to abuse or neglect. That is why the work of Safe Families Canada is so important; through our screened volunteers we can provide that safe extended family-like support network to families who have nowhere else to turn.

Your generous support will allow us to continue serving families who are often overlooked by helping us cover overhead costs and salaries, in turn providing oversight and structure for our volunteers who would not otherwise have access to these families or ever hear their stories. One child in foster care for 1 year comes with a cost of approximately \$45,000, whereas with Safe Families, that cost to support a child for one year is only \$2500. It would be an honor if you would consider a grant of \$5000 to support our work.

Ref: Urgent Financial Request

I am writing today to bring to your attention the urgent financial needs of Adult & Teen Challenge of Central Canada. Our mission, "To offer a full range of addiction treatment and recovery services with compassion and excellence," drives us daily to serve families confronting the challenges of addiction. Right now, however, we face a significant in-year funding shortfall, nearing \$750,000 by the end of October, which jeopardizes our ability to deliver these essential services and to expand them to meet the growing need.

Every year, Adult & Teen Challenge receives over one thousand requests for assistance from people and families struggling with addiction, from across the province and increasingly from indigenous communities. In 2024 we have seen these overall numbers increase by nearly 34%. Our in-residence programs are operating near capacity, and we are receiving continual requests to add more community-based programs.

Our organization currently maintains a significant presence in your area, with an in-residence men's campus, a community office, and a Super-Thrift store providing valuable work experience for our students. We also welcome residents from the region at our facilities throughout Manitoba.

Adult & Teen Challenge programs are funded almost entirely by a combination of our micro-enterprise (Vehicle Donation Program and Super Thrift stores), fundraising events, and private donations. This year, like so many worthy not-for-profit organizations, we have experienced a significant downturn in fundraising income, due in large part to the erosion of donors' disposable income and general donor fatigue.

This serious reduction in revenue, coupled with the burgeoning demand for our services has put us in a place where our ability to deliver these life-saving programs is at risk. We do not want to turn away anybody when they desperately need our help.

There is a widely acknowledged addiction crisis in Manitoba, and Adult & Teen Challenge is doing all we can to offer solutions and help across the province, with currently very little help from Provincial and Municipal Governments. Without immediate financial assistance, and a plan for on-going, sustainable funding, these programs are at risk.

We respectfully request an urgent meeting or an opportunity to present to Council to discuss our crucial role in delivering addiction treatment and recovery programs, and how your community can assist us in addressing these serious needs now and in the future.

We look forward to your prompt response and the opportunity to meet.

Public Safety Canada would like to inform contract jurisdictions that the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) will be starting the deployment of body-worn cameras during the third week of November 2024.

Over the summer months, the RCMP held discussions with contract jurisdictions on the billing methodology for body-worn cameras. Consistent with our initial messages and discussions, contract jurisdictions will only be paying for body-worn cameras when they are implemented and operational in their jurisdiction. Initially, all jurisdictions will have body-worn cameras estimates included on their quarterly billings; however, through the regular Year End Reconciliation process, where the roll-out varies from the estimates, credits will be applied proportionally based on the actual number of cameras put into service, including a full credit if cameras are not received this year.

If you require more information about roll out plans in your jurisdiction, you are encouraged to reach out to your Division. Please note that the RCMP will continue to regularly update jurisdictions through the Contract Management Committee Body-Worn Cameras Sub-Committee.
