Payments Made Easier

Property Taxes

You can now sign up for the Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) any time. Monthly property tax payments are automatically withdrawn for your convenience, rather than a single annual payment in September. The City does not charge service fees or interest charges for this service. Contact the Tax Clerk at taxes@steinbach.ca or call 204-346-6531 for more information.

Water Bills

Pre-Authorization Plan (PAP) - quarterly water bill payments, automatically withdrawn, equal to the balance due on your quarterly utilities invoice. Deadline to sign up is two weeks prior to the next due date.

Dandelions, Living with a Noxious Weed



To some this plant is a welcome sight, used to provide that first food for our bees, to make salads and wines, among other uses. To others however, it is a nuisance and property owners will work diligently to keep their yards free of this seemingly invasive plant.

- Asphalt overlay Giesbrecht Street from Reimer Avenue West to Woodhaven Avenue.
- Road Park Road West from 100m West of Industrial Road to the Clearspring Mall's West Approach.

Please exercise caution when passing city employees completing line painting, asphalt patching, watering plants and trees, or other roadside duties this season. Thank you for respecting pylons and other safety signs set up for their protection.
