Utility Rate Adjustments

The City of Steinbach has been authorized by the Public Utilities Board (Order No. 137/23) to modify water and sewer rates for consumption starting January 1, 2024. Adjustments to the rates are as follows:

	Old Rates	New Rates for Consumption Starting	
		Jan 2024	Jan 2025
<i>Per cubic meter:</i>			
Water	\$1.08	\$1.08	\$1.10
Sewer	\$0.83	\$0.86	\$0.90
Total	\$1.91	\$1.94	\$2.00
Minimum quarterly charge for regular residential meter (15 cubic meters)	\$46.17	\$49.15	\$50.44
Basic charge	\$17.52	\$20.05	\$20.44

Overall, the rate adjustments are expected to have a minimal effect on residents' utility bills. Steinbach customers continue to enjoy some of the lowest utility rates in Manitoba.
