## 2026 Election Notice

**The general municipal election will be held on Wednesday, October 28, 2026.**

Prospective municipal election candidates must register with the Senior Election Official (SEO) during the registration period before they may begin to accept contributions, incur expenses, fundraise or borrow money for their campaign. The SEO will be receiving candidate registrations by appointment only at Steinbach City Hall for:

1. **Mayor: Between May 1, 2026 and September 22, 2026**
2. **Councillor: Between June 30, 2026 and September 22, 2026**

## Seasonal Construction Zones & Workers

Residents are asked to please use caution and obey all posted signs when travelling in or around the following construction zones this spring and summer:

- New Sanitary Sewer Force Main Construction – along Park Road West from the Steinbach Lagoon at 615 Park Road West to the Lift Station at 246 Park Road West.
- Sanitary Sewer Renewal – along Millwork Drive from PTH 12 N to Lund Road.
- Asphalt Road Overlays – on Stonebridge Crossing from PTH 12 N to Albert Street, Maplewood Street from Loewen Boulevard to Stonebridge Crossing, Cypress Place, and Meadowood Place.
- New Sidewalk Construction - Wyndham Estate Drive from Winston Place to Preston Place and in the public reserve from the southwest corner of Winston Place to the Deerfield Pathway.

Please also exercise caution when passing City employees completing line painting, asphalt patching, watering plants and trees, or other roadside duties this season. Thank you for respecting pylons and other safety signs set up for their protection.

### Pre-Authorization Plan (PAP) for Utility Bills

Quarterly water bill payments, automatically withdrawn, equal to the balance due on your quarterly utility invoice. Deadline to sign up is two weeks prior to the next due date.

### Online Utility Bill Services

Receive your quarterly water bill by email and view your statement online.

### Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)

The Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) is a payment plan that allows taxpayers to pre-authorize monthly payments for property taxes OR to pre-authorize an annual payment for the full amount on your tax statement in September each year. Monthly payments are automatically withdrawn from your chequing account at your financial institution. Your monthly payment is calculated by dividing your most recent annual tax levy or an estimate of your current year tax levy into either twelve (12) installment payments or, depending on date of enrollment, the number of months remaining in the year.
