Property Tax Statements

Property tax statements are mailed to the current owners at time of printing and are due on **September 29, 2026**. It is the property owners' responsibility to obtain a copy should they have recently purchased a property and not received a tax statement. If you are expecting a tax statement and have not yet received a copy or if your mailing address has changed recently, please contact City Hall at 204-326-9877 or email taxes@steinbach.ca.

How to Pay Your Taxes

Recommended: TIPP Program

The Tax Installment Payment Plan allows you to have your current tax bill divided into automatic monthly payments on the first business day of each month over the remaining months of the current year, or to pre-authorize a single annual payment for the total balance on the due date in September.



Online banking. The City of Steinbach is registered to accept online bank payments. Please be aware of your financial institution's processing time to ensure your online payment is received by the due date.

Mail a cheque along with the bottom portion of the tax bill. Cheques can be made payable to the City of Steinbach and mailed to the address at the top of this page. Please ensure payments are received at City Hall on or before the due date.



In person by cheque or debit. Bring your tax bill and payment to City Hall (see address above) between 8am and 4pm, Monday to Friday. Credit cards are not accepted. If paying by debit, please ensure you have set up the necessary limit with your bank.



24 Hour Cheque Drop Off. Along with the bottom portion of the tax bill, cheques can be submitted via the drop box located at the Administration entrance of City Hall, facing Reimer Avenue. It is not advised to put cash in the drop box.

The Senior Election Official (SEO) will be receiving candidate registrations by appointment only at City Hall for:

1. **Mayor: Between May 1 and September 22**
2. **Councillor: Between June 30 and September 22**

To obtain a registration form, please contact the SEO. **To be added or to confirm that you are on the voters list**, please contact the SEO or fill out the online form.

Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the City of Steinbach can have their name added to the Voters List, or have any information about the voter on the Voters List corrected. A person is eligible if they are:

- a Canadian citizen; and
- at least 18 years of age on election day (October 28); and
- a resident of the City of Steinbach for at least six months prior to election day (April 28), OR a registered owner of land in the City of Steinbach for at least six months prior to election day (April 28).
